COMPETITOR DIRECTIONS

Terminology:

CP – Check point. *Teams must use their Passports to record proof of arrival.*

TA – Transition Area. *Teams have access to their gear bags for a change of discipline.*

Not Shown on Map – *The described feature is not shown on the official map provided but has been verified as described.*

Not Labelled on Map – *The described feature is shown on the official map provided, but is not labelled.*

FRS Race Frequency: 3.0

Bag 1: Mountain Biking (Stage 2) & Trekking (Stage 3)

Bag 2: Paddling (Stage 4)

Unstaffed CPs will have an orange & white Orienteering flag with a punch. Teams must punch the appropriate CP box on their passports.

NOTE: At no time are teams allowed to travel along Hwys 69, 169, or 400 (not shown on map), by any means, other than when expressly permitted in these directions. The new Hwy 400 extension begins from Hwy 69 at UTM 955938, through UTM 947021 and 917098.

The start is located at Wallace Marina at Red Leaves Resort.

STAGE 1: TREKKING

MP1

UTM 057035

MP1 is located where a cottage road meets a highway. From the start, make your way to MP1 using the provided trail map.

CP1

UTM 049031

CP1 is located on an old bridge. From MP1, cross the road with the help of Race Marshals, and make your way to CP1.

CP2

UTM 043044

CP2 is located at a stream on a lake. From CP1, make your way to CP2.

CP3/TA1

UTM 042048

CP3/TA1 is located where a trail meets a road. From CP2, make your way to CP3/TA1.

STAGE 2: MOUNTAIN BIKING

CP4

UTM 911101

CP4 is located along a gravel road, just east of a railway crossing. From CP3/TA1, proceed north on Hwy 632 to UTM 034089. Continue west on Stanley House Rd (not labelled on map) to UTM 013084. Continue generally north on a dirt road, through a gravel pit to access an ATV trail (not shown on map) heading generally north at UTM 008094. We have permission from the owners, so don't mind the "No Trespassing" signs. Continue generally north until this trail (not shown on map) meets a trail (shown on map) at UTM 985126. Continue generally west on roads shown on map, crossing Hwy 69 at UTM 933105, following a road (not shown on map) from UTM 930103 to UTM 925102, and make your way to CP4.

CP5

UTM 876059

CP5 is located where a trail crosses under a Hydro Line. From CP4, continue on trails to a junction (not shown on map) at UTM 898075. From here, follow trails (not shown on map) to CP5.

ADVANCED CUTOFF: Teams must leave CP5 by 1130 to undertake the advanced course. This cutoff is on the honour system; please make your decisions wisely!

CP6/TA2 – Regular teams

UTM 912032

CP6/TA2 is located at a fenced area alongside a road. From CP5, make your way to CP6/TA2.

ADVANCED MOUNTAIN BIKE

CPA (Advanced Only)

UTM 903042

CPA is located at a stream crossing between two lakes. From CP5, make your way to UTM 882047, and continue generally east on a trail. At UTM 897036, a trail (not shown on map) continues generally northeast to CPA.

CP6/TA2 – Advanced teams

UTM 912032

CP6/TA2 is located at a fenced area alongside a road. From CPA, continue on a trail (not shown on map) generally east, to UTM 910042. From here, make your way to CP6/TA2.

CUTOFF: Teams must leave CP6/TA2 by 1300 to continue on the course. The alternate course is to bike directly to CP8/TA3 and continue on the paddle.

STAGE 3: TREKKING

CP7

UTM 928066

CP7 is located east of a trail bridge over Hwy 400. From CP6/TA2, make your way to CP7.

MP2

UTM 955051

MP2 is a mandatory crossing point of Hwy 69. Teams may travel along Hwy 69 from UTM 949058 to MP2, but may only cross at MP2. From CP7, make your way to MP2.

CP8/TA3

UTM 956052

CP8/TA3 is located at a picnic area. From MP2, cross Hwy 69 to CP8/TA3.

CUTOFF: Teams must leave CP8/TA3 by 1500 to continue on the course.

STAGE 4: PADDLING

FINISH

UTM 064022

The finish is located at Cleveland's dock. From CP8 / TA3, make your way to the Finish!
