



WHAT IS THE SALOMON ADVENTURE CHALLENGE SERIES?

Introduced last year, the Salomon Adventure Challenge is a series of 5-8 hour adventure races focused on fun and accessibility. These races are targeted at those that are interested in outdoor sports, but not committed to the months of training and preparation required for the longer Raid the North races. Each race includes mountain biking, trekking and paddling across 40+ kms of unmarked terrain, with some surprise challenges such as river crossings or bushwhacking .

This year we have expanded the race series to include six races held in conjunction with our Raid the North events, and three stand alone races, one of which will be held this winter (winter race will involve cross-country skiing, snowshoeing and mountain biking). This year we have reduced our team size from four to three members -- standard team size for this length of race. With the focus squarely on participation, there are no restrictions on team composition (all male, all female and mixed categories exist) and the minimum age has been reduced to 16 years of age.
